

Workshop: Editing in Audacity

This month, we're diving straight into the art and technique of audio editing. After many requests for a dedicated editing session, we're excited to offer a workshop focused entirely on helping you build confidence and skill inside Audacity.

What You'll Learn

- Download and install Audacity on your computer (required for the workshop).
- Navigate and understand the Audacity editing suite.
- Import WAV audio files into your project.
- Edit audio, including applying fade-in and fade-out effects.
- Add royalty-free music to your episodes.
- Adjust and balance audio and music levels.
- Save and export your finished files.
- Understand the differences between common audio formats (WAV, MP3, etc.)
- Organise and manage audio files on your computer.

What You'll Need

- A computer (laptops only; tablets and iPads are not supported).
- The Audacity program installed (help can be provided).
- A recorded WAV audio file to practice with (or we can provide one).
- Headphones (available to borrow if needed).

Who Should Attend

- Anyone seeking ideas and inspiration for content development (all levels welcome).
- Previous participants of a course or masterclass wanting to move ahead with their own podcast or audio project.
- People interested in learning what Plantation Studios can offer in terms of studio hire and production.
- Anybody looking for an intimate and enriching day of skill sharing and motivation.

- Come along with an open mind and engage in imaginative discussions around the monthly theme.
